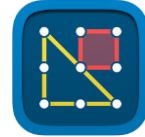

A spreadsheet app that includes support for Multi-Touch gestures so you can create powerful spreadsheets.



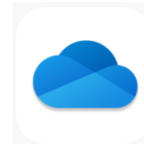
iMovie
